



## Frequently Asked Questions

### **What are the event dates?**

Monday, July 15 is a travel day.

Tuesday, July 16 – Thursday, July 18 are full days of activities.

Friday, July 19 is a travel day.

A full event schedule will be shared closer to the date.

### **Where can I find details about my child's attendance at YE Summit?**

Youth Entrepreneurs (YE) staff will be hosting several family meetings in April to answer any questions and communicate the goals and expectations. Paperwork and deadlines will also be shared in these in-person, video feed or conference call meetings. ### **Where will YE Summit attendees stay during the week?**

All attendees of YE Summit will be staying at the DoubleTree Hotel in Dearborn, Michigan. Floors will be separated by males and females. Each room will have two beds. Attendees will be assigned a roommate. Chaperones will be present during the event to ensure the safety of students.

### **How will YE Summit attendees travel to Detroit?**

YE will plan and cover all financial costs of travel via commercial airline to Detroit. If car or train transportation to Detroit is more efficient those plans and costs will also be handled by YE. ### **How will YE Summit attendees travel while in Detroit?**

Attendees will travel between several destinations inside the Detroit metro area. Group bus transportation will be organized by YE. Chaperones will be present during the event to ensure the safety of students.

### **What will YE Summit attendees eat during that week?**

All food and drinks will be provided by and paid for by YE during the entirety of YE Summit, including travel dates. Special dietary requests will be collected during the application process and accommodated for accordingly.

### **Is a cell phone or smartphone required at the event?**

No, but YE wants to leverage available technology and will ask if you plan on bringing one to the event.



### **How was my student selected for this opportunity?**

YE Summit 2019 was open to all actively engaged Youth Entrepreneurs students and alumni ranging from ages 16-20. Each applicant went through a rigorous application process including but not limited to seeking a letter of recommendation and completing an aptitude assessment called YouScience. Out of over 600 applicants, 300 students were selected.

### **What is YouScience?**

YouScience is an assessment that allows users to explore their career interests and aptitudes, review personalized career matches and develops affirming language to better highlight their skills.

### **How do I access to the registration page?**

The student and/or parent must complete the survey link sent by email and/or physical mail to receive the event registration link via email.

### **How are students/parents notified of travel arrangements?**

Airfare will be booked through Youth Entrepreneurs. Each individual will receive confirmation when arrangements have been made.

### **Will transportation be provided to/from the airport?**

Students and parents will be responsible for transportation to/from their designated airports (As specified during registration). There will be a group of Insiders and YE staff to meet individuals at the Detroit airport. After they arrive, your student will be bussed to the hotel for check-in.

### **Will we receive confirmation after completing registration?**

Upon completion of registration, a confirmation screen will be shown.

### **What if my student experiences a layover and has a connecting flight?**

If an issue occurs with flights, Youth Entrepreneurs will be in constant communication with the students. Please ensure that YE has up to date contact information for your student.

### **Will students fly/room with people from the same location?**

If possible, students from the same location will travel as a group. Roommate selection will be based on gender and paired at random. You cannot select or request your roommate.

### **How do we know what airport to fly out of?**

During registration, students and/or the responsible individual has the option to select their desired airport. Students are encouraged to research which airports are closest to them when registering.



**Will our students need spending money?**

Youth Entrepreneurs will cover expenses to include food, lodging and travel. Your student may bring additional spending money for recreational purposes.

**Do students who are local to Detroit still need to complete the travel forms?**

Yes, all students, including locals, need to fill out the travel documentation.

**Are students allowed to check luggage at the airport?**

Yes. Based on aircraft carrier, there may be additional fees. Additional information will be provided concerning luggage after flights have been booked.

**For first time flyers, will you be able to provide more information on how to travel and what to bring?**

Youth Entrepreneurs will be in contact with first time flyers in order to ensure they feel well equipped to fly. If there are any additional questions about flying, please utilize [tsa.gov](http://tsa.gov) and the aircraft carrier's website.

**What are valid forms of identification for flying?**

Some valid forms of identification include a driver's license, passport, and military IDs. For questions about acceptable forms of identification, please refer to <https://www.tsa.gov/travel/security-screening/identification>

**What do I do if my form of identification expires before Summit?**

Upload your current ID during the registration process. Whenever your ID is updated, please send a copy to [yesummit@youthentrepreneurs.org](mailto:yesummit@youthentrepreneurs.org) Please ensure that you have current identification prior to Summit. You will not be able to board the plane with an expired ID.

**Who do we send the identification to?**

Students will upload their government issued identification during the registration process.
